Constitutional Rights at Home

Unalienable Redemption

DO THEY HAVE A WARRANT?

Ask: "Do you have a warrant?"

IF YES (They have a warrant):

Say: "Please slide the warrant under the door"

Verify warrant has:

- ✓ Signed by judge
- ✓ Correct address
- ✓ Your name (if arrest warrant)
- ✓ Specific items to search for

If valid: You must allow entry

If invalid: "I do not consent to entry"

IF NO (No warrant):

✓ SAY:

"I do not consent to any searches."

"Am I free to close the door?"

Do NOT open door. Do NOT step outside.

COMMON POLICE TACTICS

They say: "We just want to talk"

You say: "I prefer not to answer questions."

They say: "Can we come in?"

You say: "I do not consent to entry."

They say: "We can get a warrant"

You say: "Then please do so."

EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES (Rare)

Police CAN enter without warrant if:

- Someone inside is in danger
- Evidence is being destroyed
- Suspect is escaping

NEVER SAY (Sovereign Citizen Myths):

- "Show me your oath and bond"
- "I don't consent to joinder"
- "I'm a sovereign citizen"
