

TRAFFIC STOP QUICK REFERENCE

Constitutional Rights During Traffic Stops

Unalienable Redemption

WHEN PULLED OVER

STEP 1: Pull Over Safely

- Turn on hazard lights
- Pull to safe location
- Turn off engine
- Hands on steering wheel (visible)

STEP 2: "Do you know why I pulled you over?"

✓ SAY: "No, officer."

✗ DON'T SAY: "I was speeding" or any admission

STEP 3: Provide Documents

✓ DO: Give license, registration, insurance immediately

✗ DON'T SAY: "I'm traveling, not driving" (NEVER WORKS)

CRITICAL MOMENT: SEARCH REQUEST

Officer asks: "Can I search your vehicle?"

✓ SAY CLEARLY:

"I do not consent to searches."

Then: Do not physically resist if they search anyway. Challenge in court later.

WHAT NOT TO DO

NEVER USE THESE (Sovereign Citizen Myths - 0% Success):

- "I'm traveling, not driving"
- "I don't need a license"
- "Show me your oath and bond"
- "I don't consent to joinder"
- "This is a commercial crime"

RESULT: Arrest, vehicle impounded, additional charges

KEY PHRASES TO MEMORIZE

1. "No, officer."
2. "I do not consent to searches."
3. "Am I free to leave?"

YOUR RIGHTS

4th Amendment: Protection against unreasonable searches

You **MUST** provide ID - All states require this

You **CAN** refuse consent to vehicle searches

Silence is **NOT** enough - Must clearly state: "I do not consent"
